Minutes of the November 21, 2019 Membership Meeting

Call to Order and Introductions

- President Lyon opened the regular membership meeting at Easton Utilities, 201 N.
 Washington Street, Easton, MD 21601.
- Mission Statement: Our mission is to assist excavators, facility owners, and the
 public in the prevention of underground damages, service outages, personal
 injury, and their associated repercussions, through education and the promotion of
 the One Call System.
- 31 members were present.
- Those present gave the customary introductions.
- Brad Ebaugh made a motion to approve minutes, Wendy Stack seconded, unanimously approved by the members.

Presentation- Jim Crowley, Manager – Gas, Meter & Corporate Safety, Easton Utilities

- Mr. Crowley provided his appreciation for the utility locating community.
- A video was provided of a truck sliding off of a highway in Illinois. The point was made that we need to always be aware of our surroundings, the road is a dangerous place.
- Mr. Crowley explained a situation in Easton in March 2019 where a car drove through barriers and flipped over. Rich Ross mentioned that there is a traffic manager school that could be beneficial to confirm that all construction sites are up to safety standards.
- Mr. Crowley also provided a list of top ten locator safety issues to the audience.

General Locate Issues

- Concerns were brought up from the audience on how to submit an ITIC dig ticket. Steve Keyser provided a short tutorial.
- Concerns from the audience on the Verizon clearinghouse protocol. Raymond Shank mentioned that you should file a discrepancy after a ticket is submitted, await the response that the ticket is marked by Utiliquest. Additionally, Mr. Shank mentioned that Verizon will not bill excavator when a damage occurs and was not marked by Verizon.
- Mr. Lyon provided a quick tutorial on how to report a damage or a violation of the State
 Damage Prevention Law through the PSC website: https://depsc.delaware.gov/report-a-damage/.
- A question was raised about the expiration length of a ticket. Mr. Lyon stated that technically, there is no expiration of a ticket, provided that the scope does not change, and the marks are maintained.
- A question was provided about the designer tickets not having a positive response. The Board will discuss having this adjusted in the future.

Public Awareness

- There was a contractor breakfast held at Chesapeake Utilities in Dover, DE on November 14, 2019, approximately 40 people were in attendance.
- A November 15, 2019 training for Bolden Construction was conducted by Mr. Kesyer.
- Mr. Keyser mentioned that the Greater Chesapeake Damager Prevention and Training Conference had another successful year, over 400 people attended.
